



## LAB BOOK GRAPH IN 3-D (User's Manual, pgs. 1414-1415)

You can display results in the Lab Book using a threedimensional type graph, instead of the original twodimensional format. Let's see how to do this:


- 1. Press View\Lab Book.
- 2. Enter Kelly Erickson is the name of the patient and press **OK**.
- Assuming you have some test results for this patient for BUN and creatinine, press Utility\Graph.
- 4. Specify a **Begin Date** and **End Date** for the range of time you wish to include in the graph.
- Enter up to 6 test names that you wish to see displayed in the graph, such as BUN and CREATININE.
- Check the 3D box to indicate that you wish to see a three-dimensional graph. The program remembers whether you last checked or unchecked this box and continues to show you the same type of graph until you change the check mark.

7. Press **OK** to see the graph.






8. Note that you can check or uncheck the Show Values box. Check this to see each individual test result displayed as a little label on the graph.



- Note that you can click on any of the graphs to move them toward the back of the display in order to see other graphs more clearly.
- Note that you can press File to save the graph to a file on your hard drive.
- 11. You can press **Print** to print the graph on your printer.
- 12. Press **Cancel** to close the graph.
- 13. Uncheck the **3D** box and press
- View the graph in its original twodimensional form.
